- The Parent Toddler Program will be run from the **Charlestown Multi Purpose Centre, 17 James Street, Charlestown.**
- We have access to a large kitchen and adjoining room with a gated and grassed outside area.
- Please bring a washed piece of fruit for shared morning tea.
- The Parent Toddler Program will run every Wednesday from 9.00am-11.00am. Fees are based on a Termly Fee and will run in conjunction with the school term. During school holidays there is no Parent Toddler Program. Termly fees will vary dependent on the number of weeks in the school term. Each session is \$25 and the termly Fee will be paid in advance. There is a 50% discount for a second sibling. Upon enrolment an account will be sent to you detailing fees for the term and payment information.
